- **Reading/Geography** – Internet research or read some online e-books to find out some information about tropical islands.
- **Writing** – Create a persuasive travel guide or information brochure to encourage people to visit the island. Include information about the following things:
 - Weather/climate
 - Write a description about the unique animal species that can be found on the island
 - What you can see, do and experience whilst on your travels around the island
- **Maths** – Design an island-themed maths board game (using your times tables knowledge)
- **Art/design** - Create your own unique animal species for the island, Sketch, draw, paint, collage or make a 3D model of this new animal species. Then explain how to care for this new species of animal
